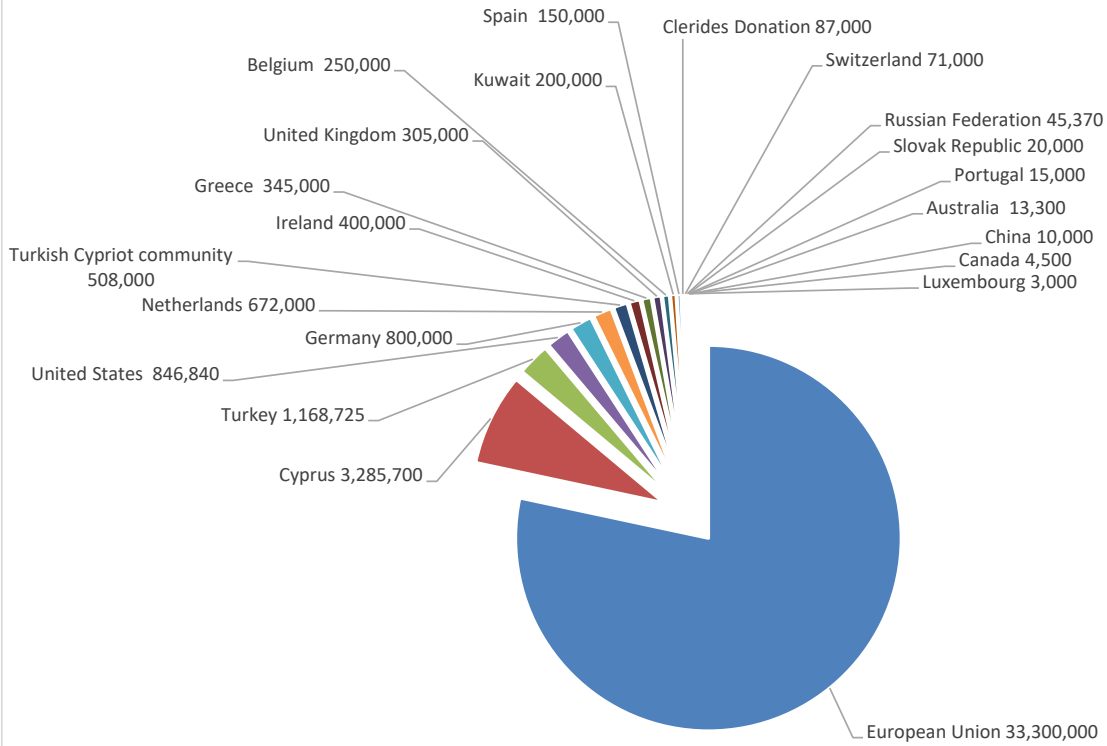

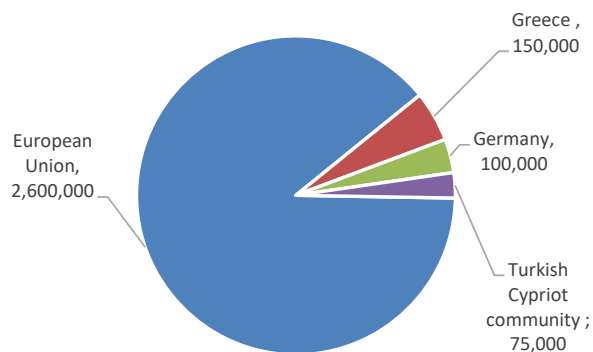
CMP Donors 2006 - 2022

(in EUR)



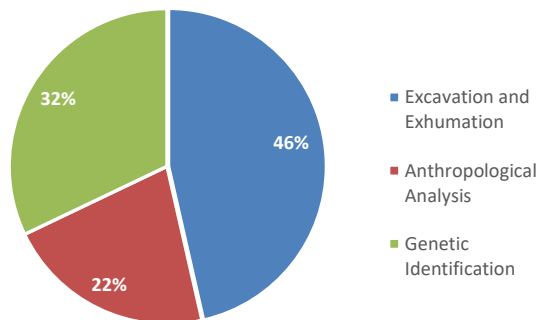
Donors Contributions 2022
