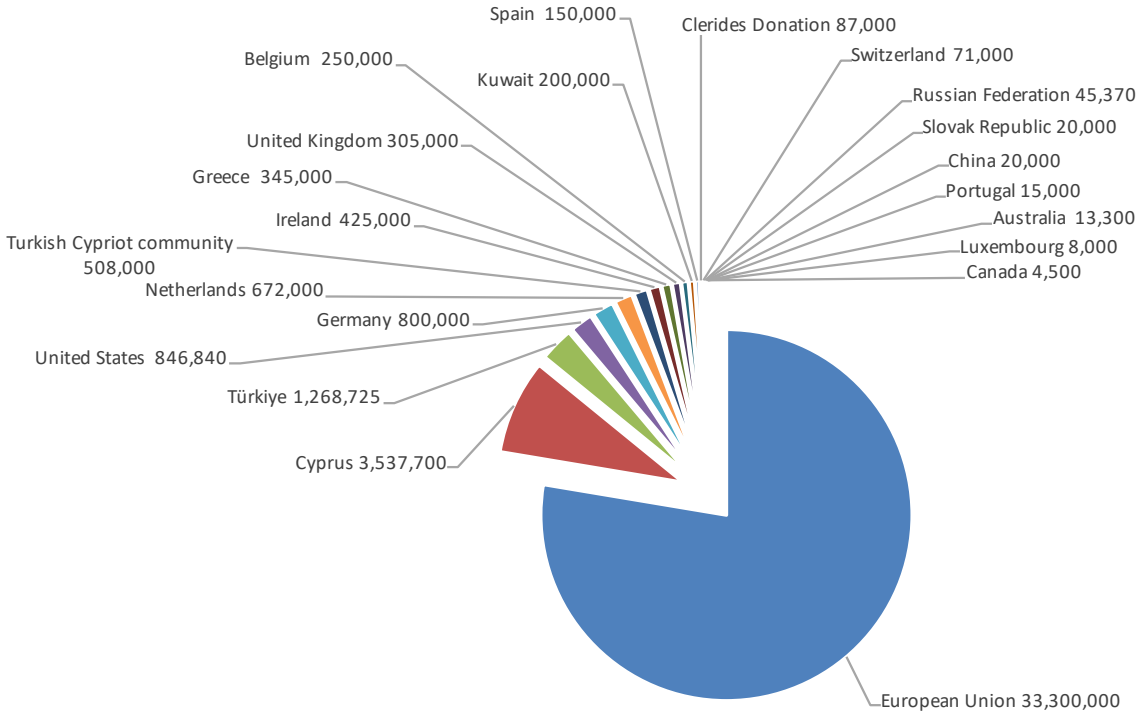

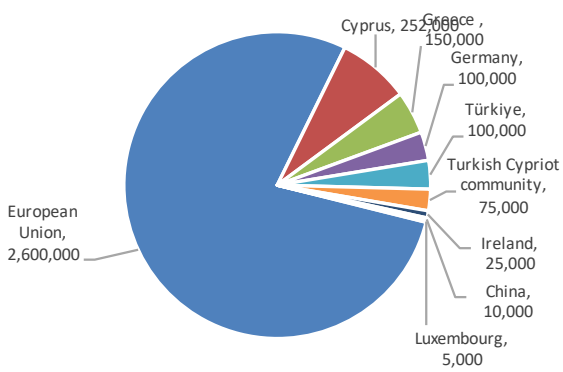
### CMP Donors 2006 - 2022

(in EUR)



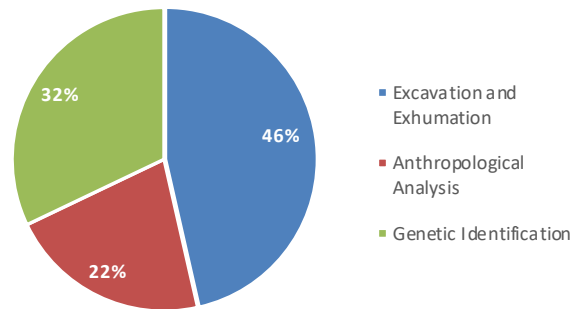
### Donor Contributions 2022
