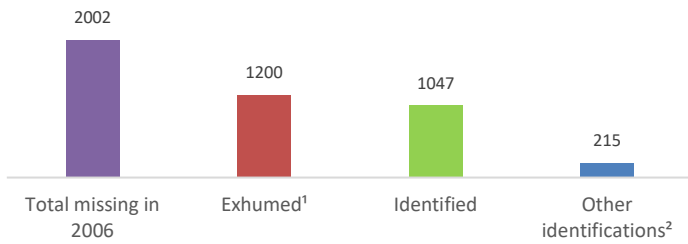
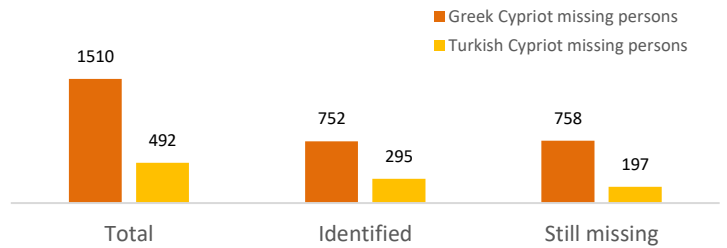


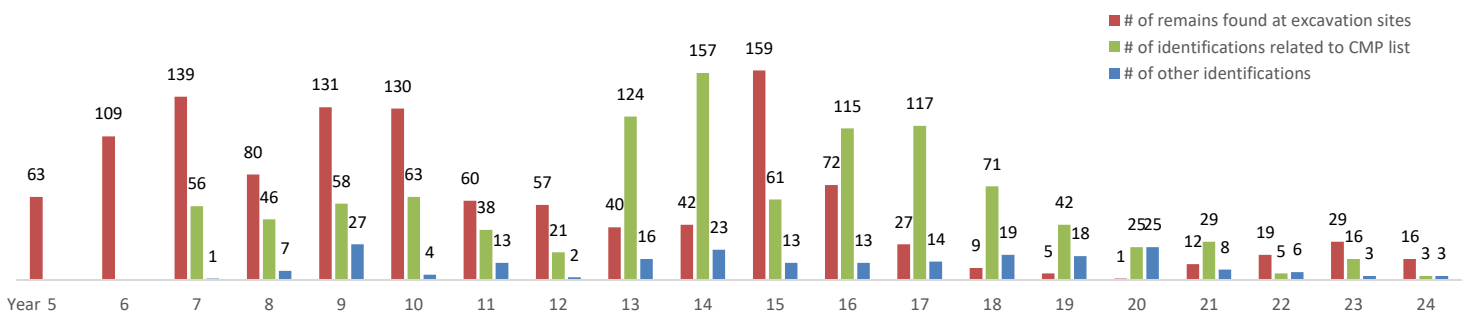

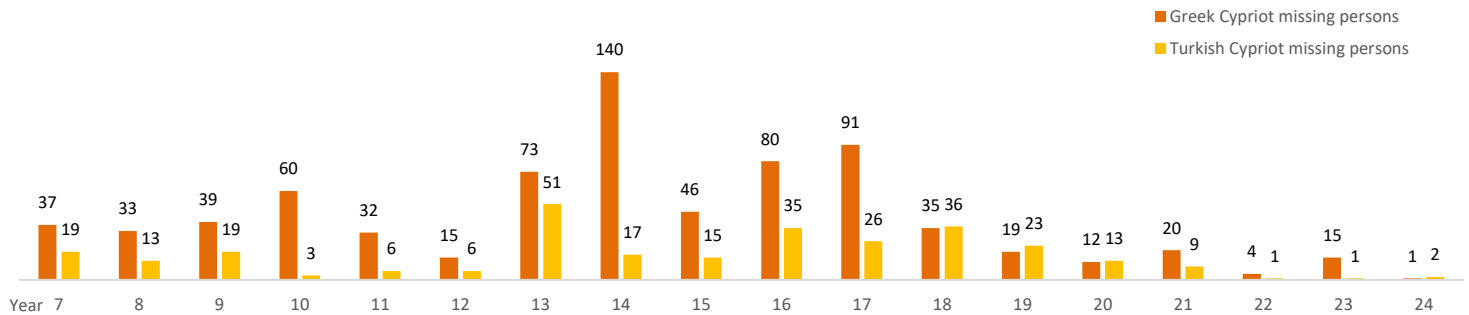
## Greek Cypriot and Turkish Cypriot missing persons



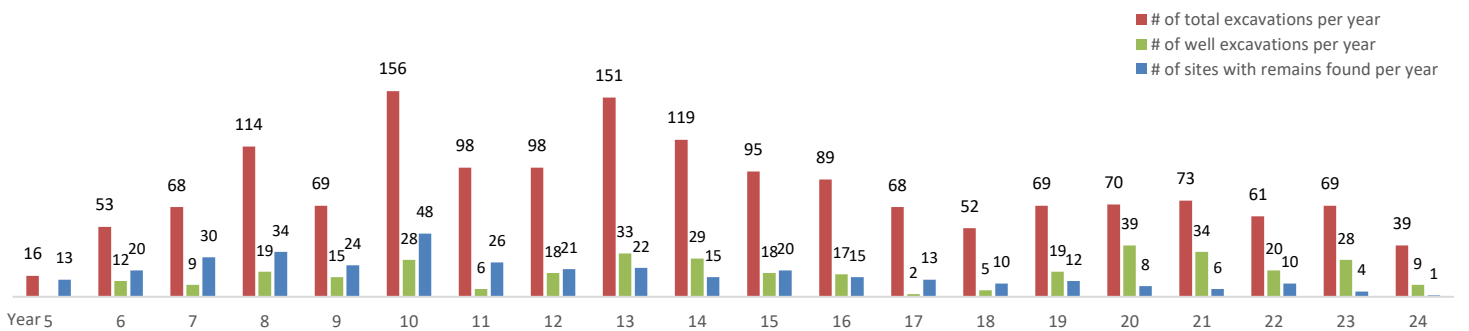
## Number of exhumations and identifications per year<sup>3</sup>

## Number of all excavations, well excavations and sites with remains found per year



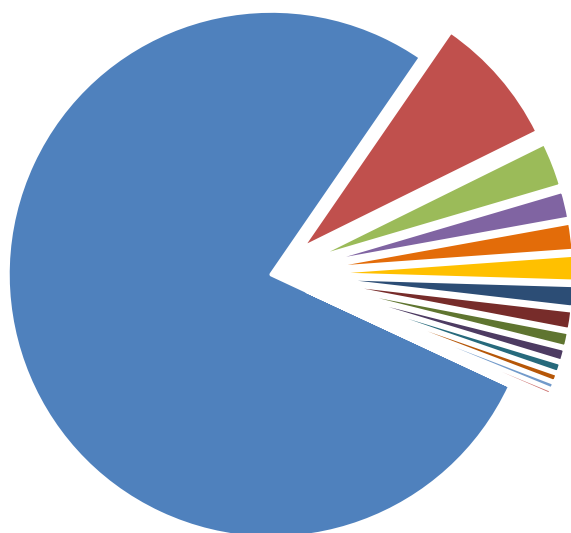

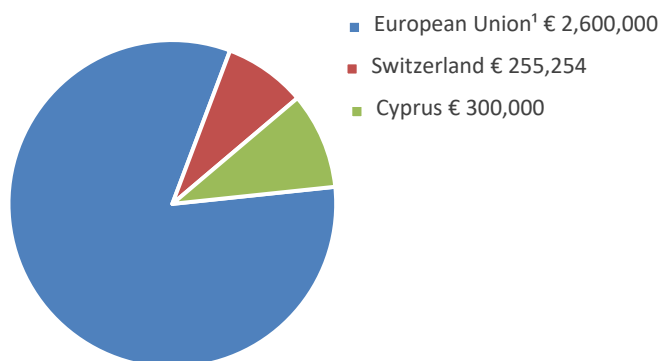
